Sawyer County Forest Access Management Plan - Greg Peterson, Sawyer County Forestry Department

Mr. Peterson provided committee members with an update on the access management plan. The access management plan (Chapter 700) is a required component of the Forestry Department's current 15-year land use plan. The plan will provide guidance in the "use" of nearly 600 miles of roads and trails in the county forest. Plan is scheduled for completion by December 2008.

Sawyer County Comp Plan Survey

Sheldon Johnson noted the survey had been distributed and surveys are being returned.

Countywide Existing Land Use Categories

Sheldon Johnson distributed a copy of the recommended existing land use categories. Further review and discussion will be held at the next meeting.

Future Invitation to Key County Departments and Other Organizations

Sheldon Johnson suggested having additional speakers provide the SCCPDC with background information pertaining to the comp plan chapters. Potential speakers will be sought over the next several months.

County Goals, Objectives and Actions Strategy

A discussion was held as to a process of developing goals, objectives and actions. A suggestion was to have Sheldon Johnson develop goals, objectives and actions based on existing town planning processes and documents of county department policies and plan reports.
